- 4. exchange insights and ideas with teachers from schools in a number of European countries and discuss about dissemination strategies.

Methodology: Participants will enjoy hands-on workshops, interactive sessions, collaborative group work and reflective journaling. This methodology should enable them to use ICT in class and to exploit and create ICT resources for teaching and Learning which might help to redefine pre-conceptions about digital competence and critical literacy in class and its implications for students' learning. Field projects should provide a real life context for creation of teaching materials.

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
